To Apply for HUD Special Funding: Unsheltered and/or Rural

Please submit a Letter of Intent for each program you wish to apply for regarding the HUD Special Funding of Unsheltered Set Aside and/or Rural Set Aside. Total funding for the CSCoC is:

Unsheltered Set Aside: \$574,404

Rural Set Aside: \$861,606

Funding formula is as follows: 50% divided equally to each of the four counties and 50% by formula based on Point-In-Time Count 2022 % of homeless.

Amador County % of homeless = 27%

Calaveras County % of homeless = 23%

Mariposa County % of homeless = 7%

Tuolumne County % of homeless = 43%
