HHAP ROUND TWO – FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

June 2, 2021

1. When answering the total number of people served, should that be the total numbers or a % of total served by the program based on funding amount. For example, if the \$85K for Mariposa is roughly 20% of our program's budget, would we only include 20% of our total numbers served when answering this question?

ANSWER: Number of people served with this project - including both requested funds and matching funds.

2. In reviewing the HHAP application, in the budget section, there is a line for New Navigation Centers and Emergency Shelters. Are only NEW programs eligible for funding from this line item? I don't see that referenced in the funding announcement, only that new programs CAN apply.

ANSWER: Revising budget page 16 Attachment B to read: New or Existing Navigation and Emergency Shelters

3. Page 7 of RFP has incorrect date. Was June 30, 2021 and should be August 25, 2021: *All applications will be reviewed by the CSCoC Rating and Ranking Committee and the Governing Board.
